

Fee Schedule

effective January 2019

Group Classes

All classes must be pre-paid.

One class/Drop-in	- \$25/dog
4-week Semester	- \$85/dog
6-week Semester	- \$125/dog

Working spots are not reserved unless paid.

No refunds/ credits for missed classes.

\$10 late fee will be assessed for payments received after the first class of the semester.

Drop-ins require pre-approval to avoid over-crowding of classes.

Private Lessons & Consultations

Available by appointment

Consultation/Evaluation (up to 30 min; no training) - \$30

30 minutes session - \$40 - expires one month after purchase

60 minutes session - \$75 - expires one month after purchase

Package of three 1-hour sessions - \$195 - expires three months after purchase

Package of six half hour sessions - \$195 - expires three months after purchase

A 24-hour cancellation policy is in effect for all lessons. If you cannot keep your appointment and fail to cancel within 24hrs, you will be responsible for payment.

Policies

PAYMENTS

All class/lesson fees must be received **no later than the semester start date** (as posted on our website). Otherwise, \$10 late fees will apply.

CREDITS & MAKE-UPS

There will be no credits or make-ups for missed classes regardless of the reason. Students may sell their working spot for a particular date to another [instructor-approved] student training at equal level.

Ongoing weekly agility classes:

Should weather affect our ability to finish class according to the schedule, credit will be issued for the remaining class(es) to be used towards the next semester.

Other agility and non-agility classes:

If we are unable to schedule a make-up session for a class that was cancelled due to weather, a credit or refund will be issued.

WITHDRAWAL & CANCELLATION

Ongoing weekly agility classes

Students are considered enrolled for each new semester and responsible for payment for their spot in class unless a **written withdrawal/cancellation request** is received **VIA EMAIL** to achieveagility@gmail.com at least 72 hours prior to the start of the new semester.

Focus Groups/Workshops/Single Session Classes/Non-Agility Group Classes

Students are responsible for payment for their working or auditing spot unless a written **withdrawal/cancellation request** is received **VIA EMAIL** to achieveagility@gmail.com at least 72 hours prior to the start of the class/workshop/focus group.

Class withdrawals with at least 24 hour notice but less than 72 hour notice will be refunded at 50% unless the spot can be filled. For withdrawals/cancellations with less than 24 hour notice refunds will be offered only if the spot can be filled. There are no refunds once the class/workshop/focus group is in session.

Private Lessons

Students are responsible for payment for their scheduled lesson unless a written **withdrawal/cancellation request** is received **VIA EMAIL** to achieveagility@gmail.com at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled appointment.

If you must cancel a lesson with less than 24 hours notice, you may send someone else to fill your spot.

GENERAL RULES

For safety reasons, all students are asked to have their dogs crated for the duration of class.

Crates are provided, or you can bring your own.

It is recommended you arrive a few minutes early to get settled so that class can start on time. Please keep your dog on leash when traveling from the car to the field and back.

For safety and liability reasons, all Agility equipment is OFF limits unless you are in class with your instructor.

Absolutely **no one is authorized to use any equipment on their own** before or after class or any other time as that is a safety concern for you and a liability to us. **Any violation of this policy can and will not be tolerated.**

Be sure to take your dog to potty prior to the start of class and always clean up after your dog (**anywhere on the property!**). Please try avoiding any accidents on the agility field and do not permit your dog to relieve himself/herself on any equipment or anything a human may have to touch (trash cans, posts, barriers, chairs, buildings,...). If he/she does, be sure to rinse it immediately.

PARKING

Please park in the main drive way in front of the house. Please avoid parking in the grass [unless there is no other option].
