## ITEMS TO BRING TO CLASS

- Dog Crate
- A hungry dog (this increases your dog's interest in food rewards)
- Plenty of small pieces of high value non-crumbling soft treats (string cheese, hot dog, fresh pet, etc.). *Treats that are dry are not recommended.*
- 1-2 favorite non-squeaking interactive toys (i.e. tug toy) to be used to reward your dog
- Water for yourself and your dog
- Harness or buckle collar, 6ft leash (no flexi leash)
- Vaccination record (Rabies, Parvo, distemper)

## GENERAL RULES

For safety reasons, all students are asked to bring crates and have their dogs crated for the duration of class.

It is recommended you arrive a few minutes early to allow enough time to get set up and potty/warm up your dog so that class can start on time. Please keep your dog on leash when traveling from the car to the field and back.

For safety and liability reasons, all Agility equipment is OFF limits unless you are in class with your instructor. This means that no one is authorized to use the agility (or any other equipment) on their own before or after class or any other time as that is a safety concern for you and a liability to us. Repeated violation of this policy will not be tolerated.

Be sure to take your dog potty prior to the start of class as well as prior to each turn in class and always clean up after your dog (anywhere on the property!). *There will be a \$10 fine for any potty accidents on the agility field.*

Please **do not permit your dog to relieve himself/herself on any equipment or anything a human may have to touch** (trash cans, posts, barriers, chairs etc). If he/she does, be sure to rinse it immediately. **Do not let your dog potty within 20ft of the front of the house/porch, the agility field, the retaining wall, entry gates or fence posts.**

A Porta John is available in the RV parking lot.

## CLASS ETIQUETTE

- Please wear comfortable footwear (no flip flops or heels); waterproof shoes are recommended for early morning classes as the field can be wet.
- Do not let your dog socialize with other dogs, but instead keep his/her focus on you.
- Be respectful of other dogs' space while keeping in mind that not all dogs are friendly.
- Follow your trainer's instructions and be attentive throughout class. We recommend watching your classmates and learning from the feedback given to each team.
- All students are expected to assist with setting jump bars to appropriate heights for each team.
- Please keep your dog under control at all times. Excessive barking cannot be tolerated.
- If you arrive late to class, DO NOT SPEED up the driveway and set up quietly. You may walk the sequence during height changes or start with the next sequence. The instructor will not repeat any discussions you may have missed.

## PARKING

Please park in the main driveway in front of the house. The RV lot may be used as overflow parking.

Please do not park in or drive through the front yard (grass area closest to the agility field).

Once you are parked, please **do not cross the main driveway to exercise your dog** as you will be leaving our property.

You may walk your dog in the open field just past the agility field.

## WEATHER

You will be notified of any cancellations (due to inclement weather) at least two hours prior to the scheduled start of class via text and/or email. Should you require more notice, please text/call your instructor directly.

Be sure to check your text/email before heading out to class as the weather here may vary from the weather near you.

### Directions

- I-26 to Exit 1
- Take SC-14 E for 0.5 miles
- Turn right onto State Rd S-42-924 for 0.5 miles
- Turn right onto S 349/State Rd S-42-349 for 0.1 miles
- Turn left onto Red Barn Rd/State Rd S-42-926 for 0.5 miles
- Turn left onto S 926/Columbus Ave/State Rd S-42-926 for 0.5 miles
- Turn right onto the narrow driveway across from the horse pasture and mailboxes
- Park in front of the first house on your right as you come up the driveway
